

Dream	During this phase, via a series of facilitated sessions, senior ProcessMAP management team will work with your key EH&S and executive management team to analyze identify various business, corporate, and regulatory requirements affecting or impacting the EH&S functions and processes, and drivers for the information management initiative. Broad requirements are identified and a “Wish List” is created.

Define	During this phase, requirements and functionalities including the scope of the project is defined. Decisions regarding integration and data migration are taken. A high level deployment plan is prepared and presented to management.
Design	The Design phase ensures a detailed plan is in place for development. This includes the project plan, requirements definition, architecture, administration and testing plans.
Develop	The Development phase leverages ProcessMAP’s unmatched experience in developing EH&S information management solutions. The system goes through customer-specific branding, configuration, enhancements/customization, security model implementation, and integration with third party systems. During this phase, the developed system is released to key audiences or few facilities for piloting and initial feedback.
Deploy	Deployment includes the installation of the configured system in the production/live environment. Site or facility-level implementation is conducted along with user training.
